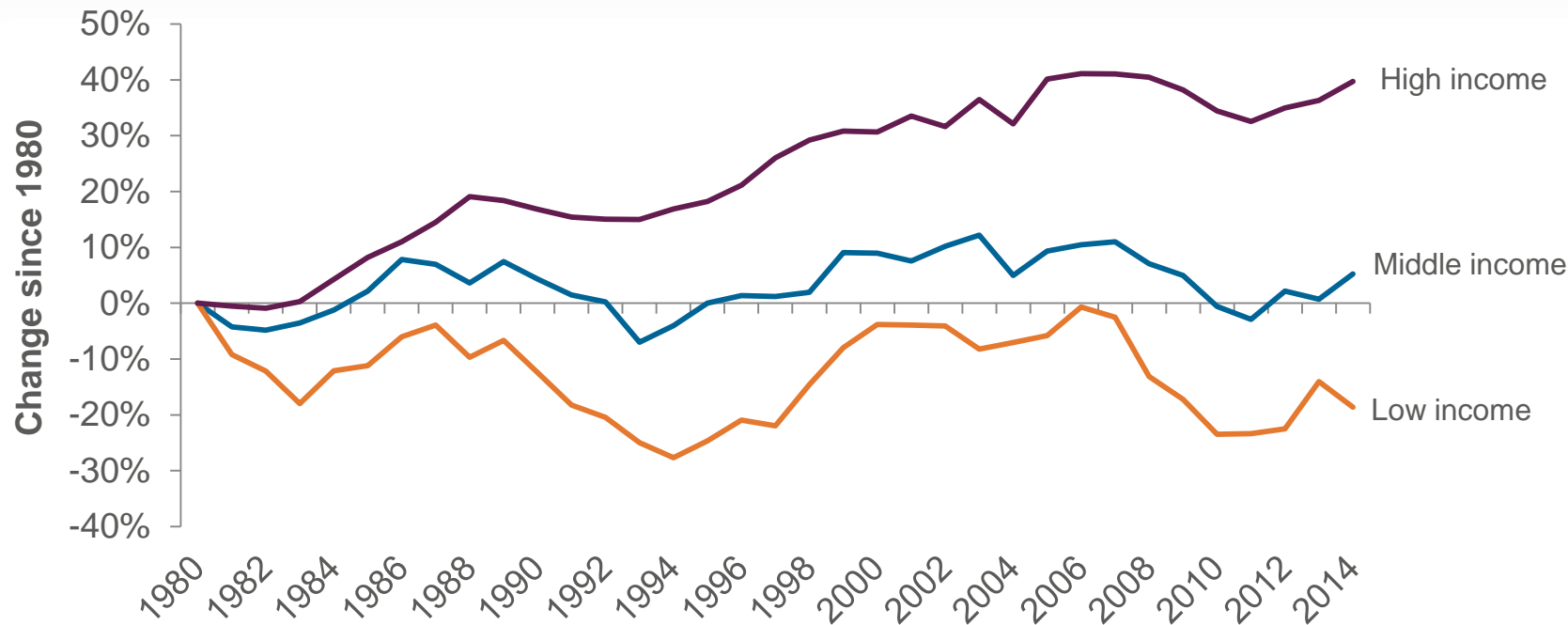

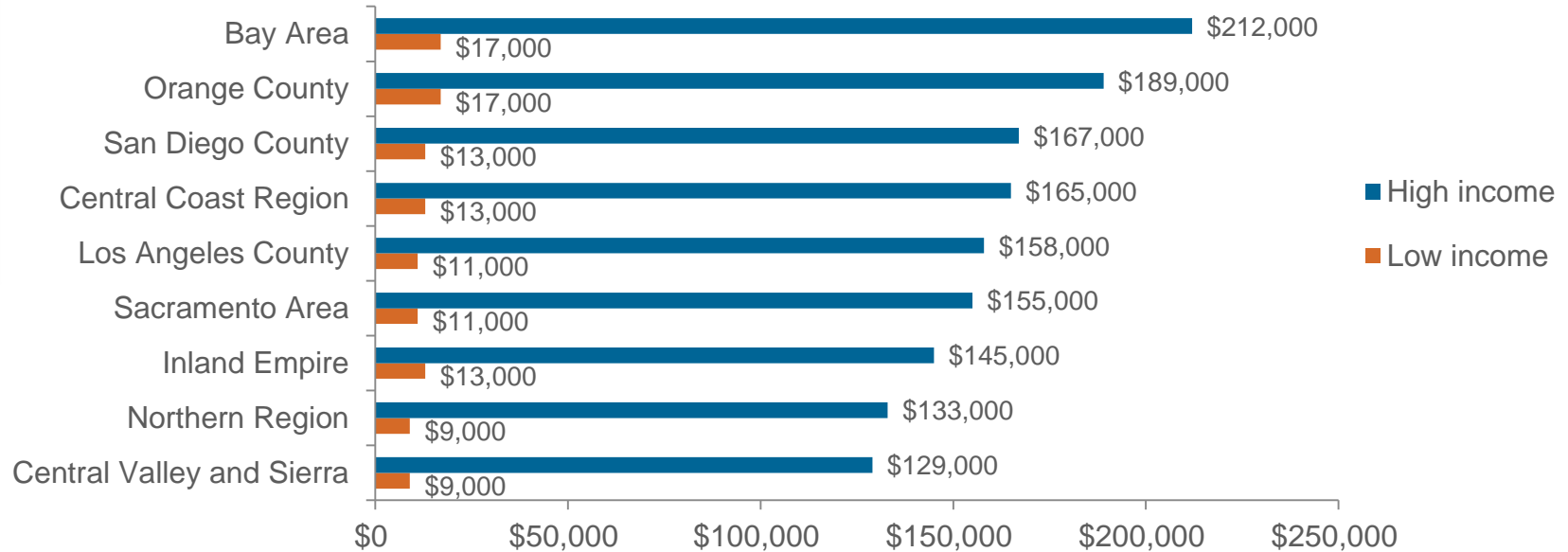

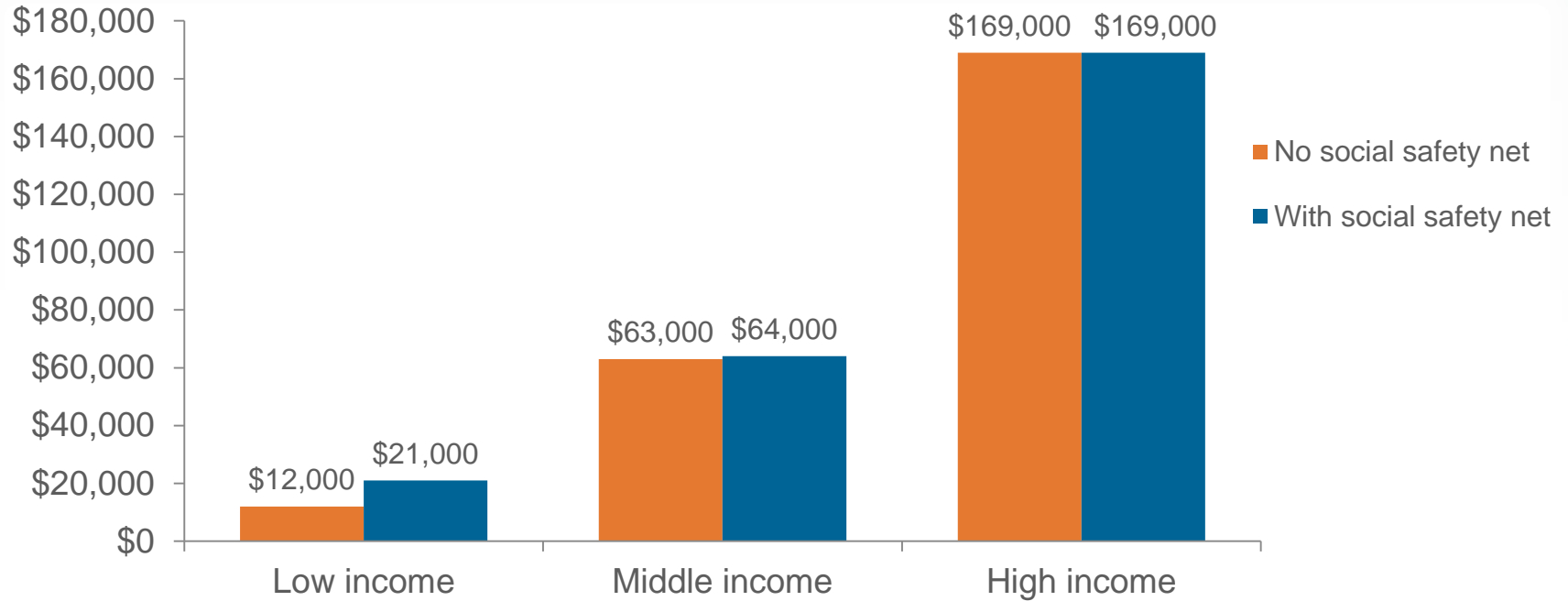
The gap between high and low incomes in California is twice as big as it was in 1980



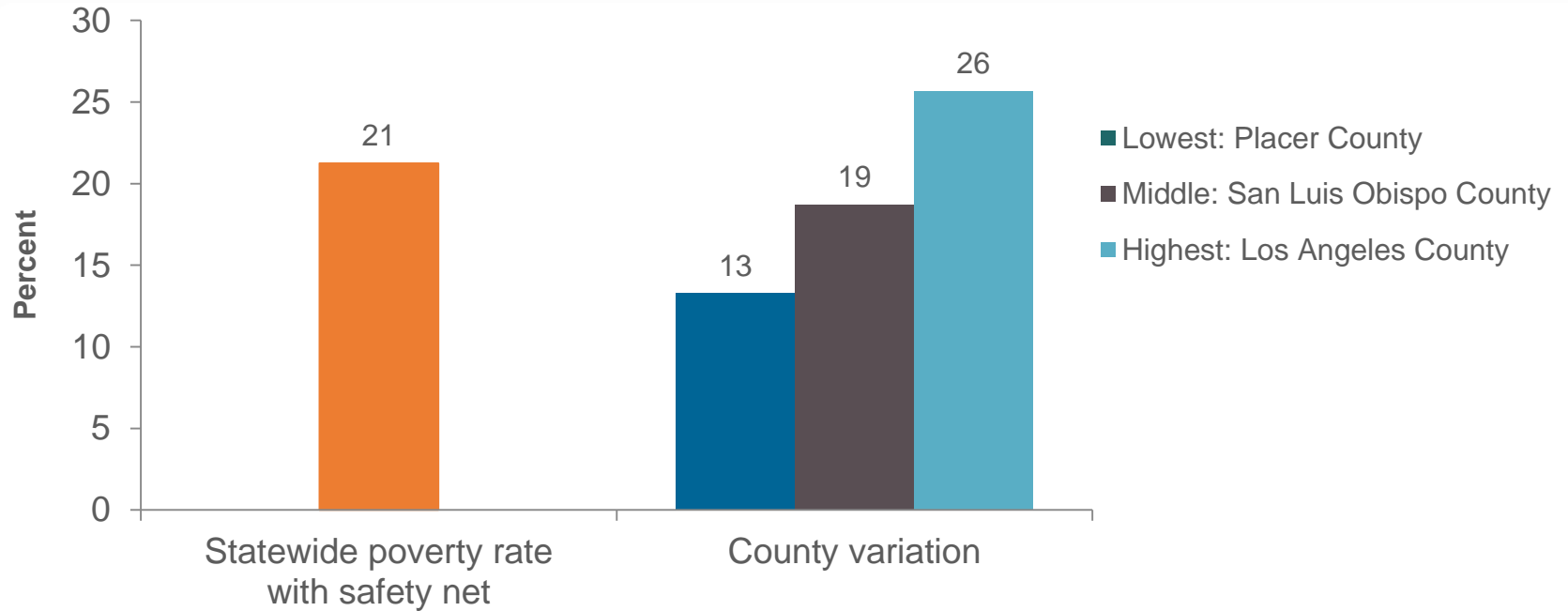
Incomes are higher in coastal regions
