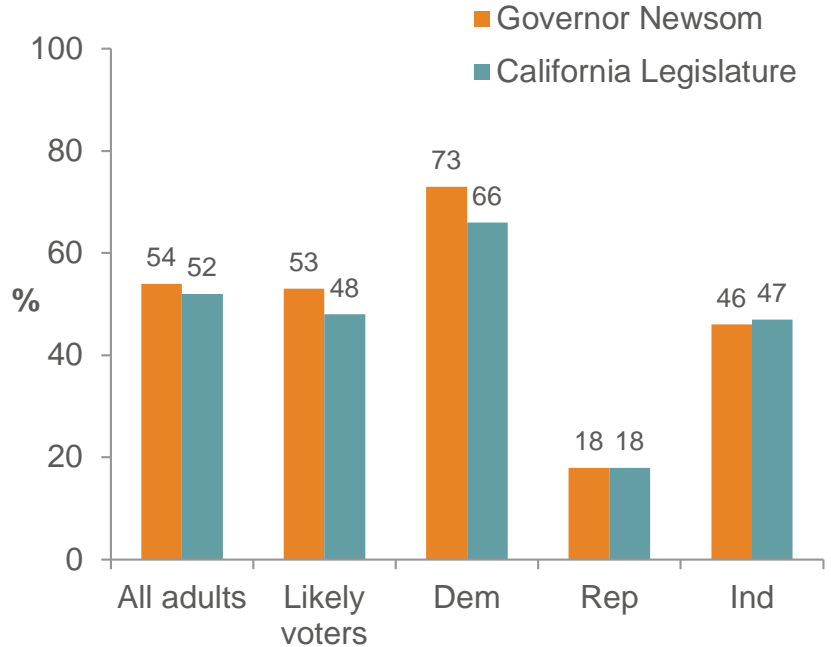
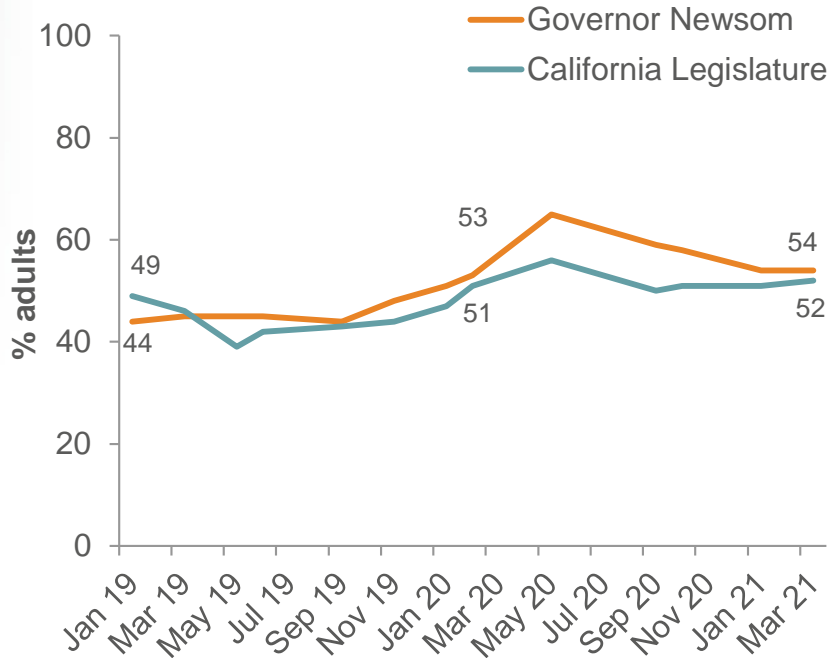

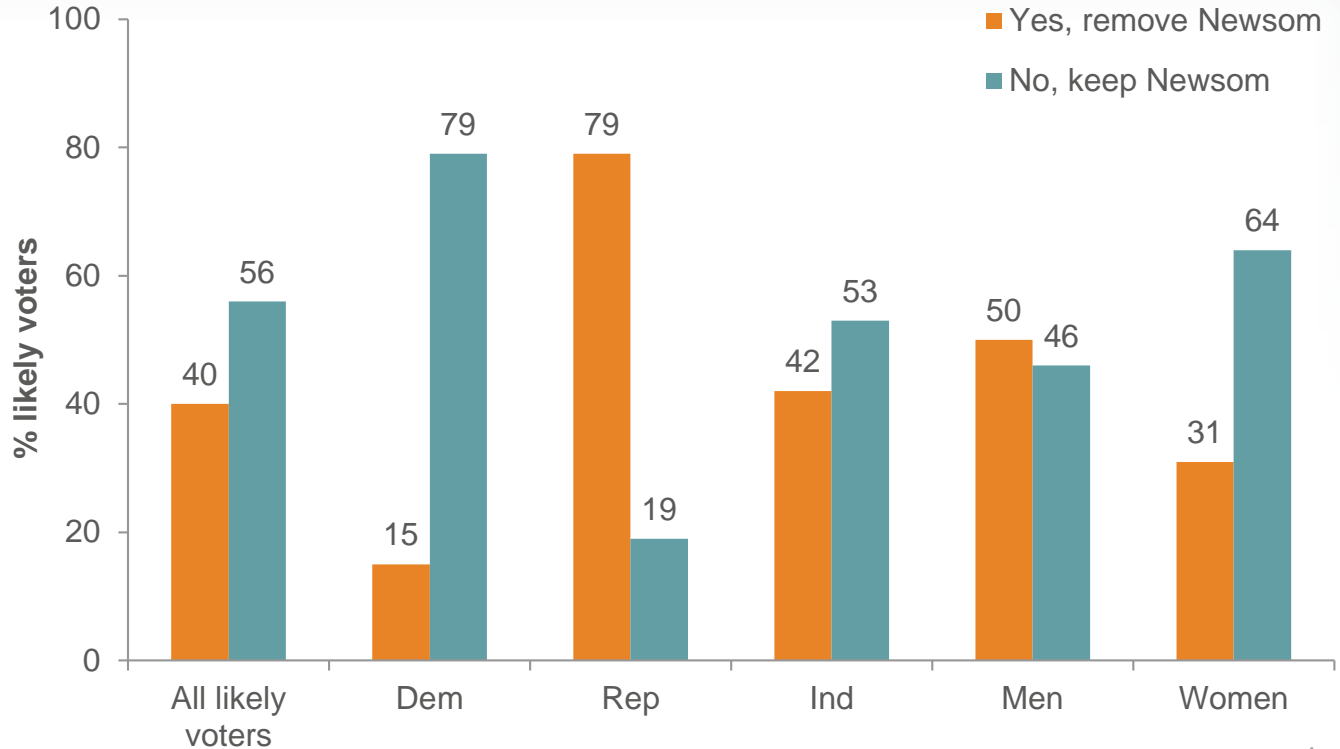
- PPIC Survey series on state and national issues since 1999
- Public perceptions, attitudes, and policy preferences
- Telephone interviews, March 14–23, 2021
 - 75% cell phone, 25% landline
 - 1,706 adults, $\pm 3.3\%$ margin of error
 - 1,174 likely voters, $\pm 3.9\%$ margin of error

Approval of state elected officials



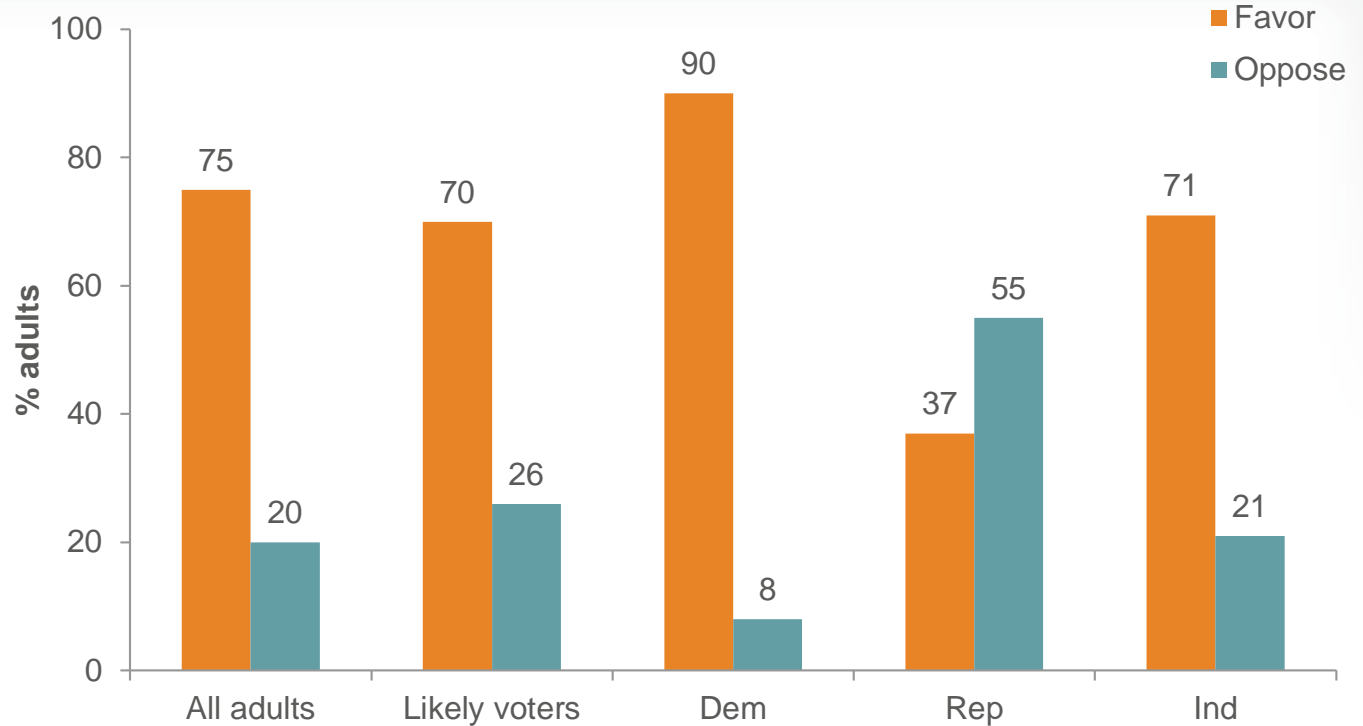
Recall of Governor Newsom

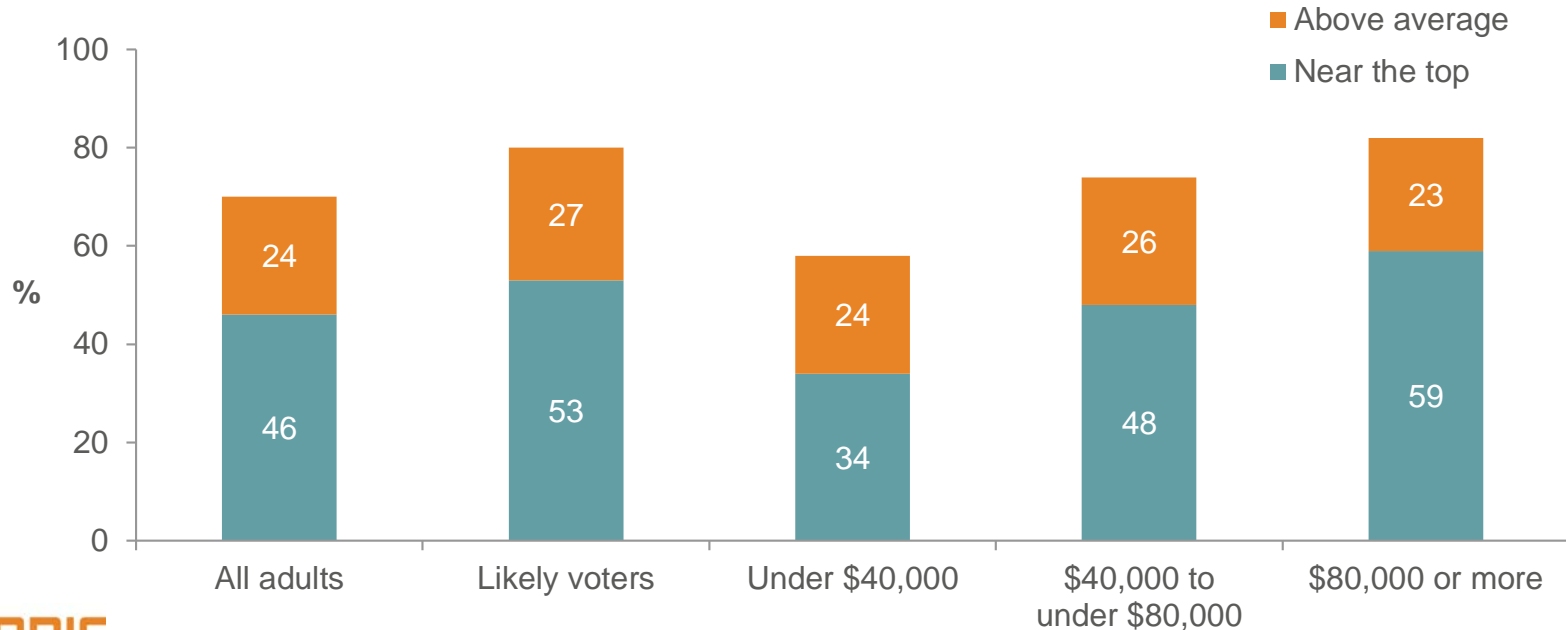
State \$7.6 billion COVID-19 relief package

Recently, the California Legislature passed and Governor Newsom signed into law a \$7.6 billion COVID relief package that includes a one-time \$600 payment to qualifying lower income Californians, as well as \$2.1 billion in immediate relief for small businesses, and over \$400 million in stipends for state subsidized child care and preschool. Do you favor or oppose this relief package?



State and local tax burden

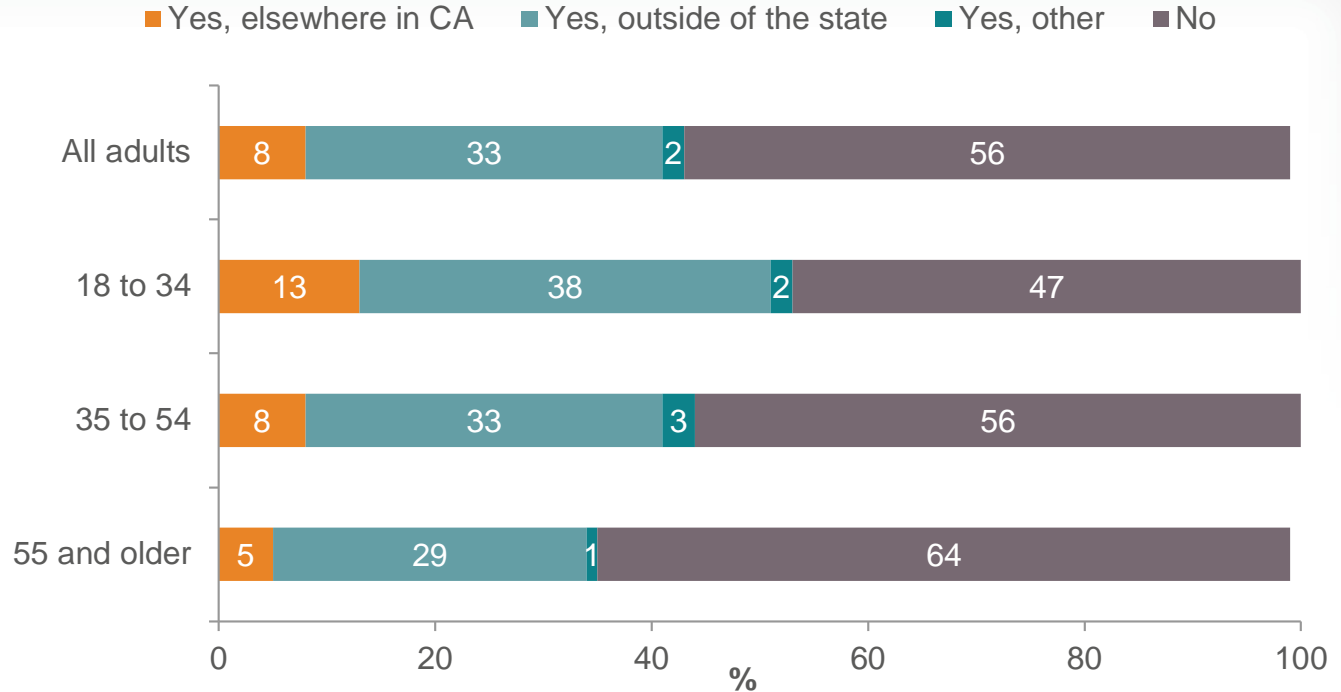
Where do you think California currently ranks in state and local tax burden per capita? Compared to other states, is California's tax burden per capita near the top, above average, average, below average, or near the bottom?



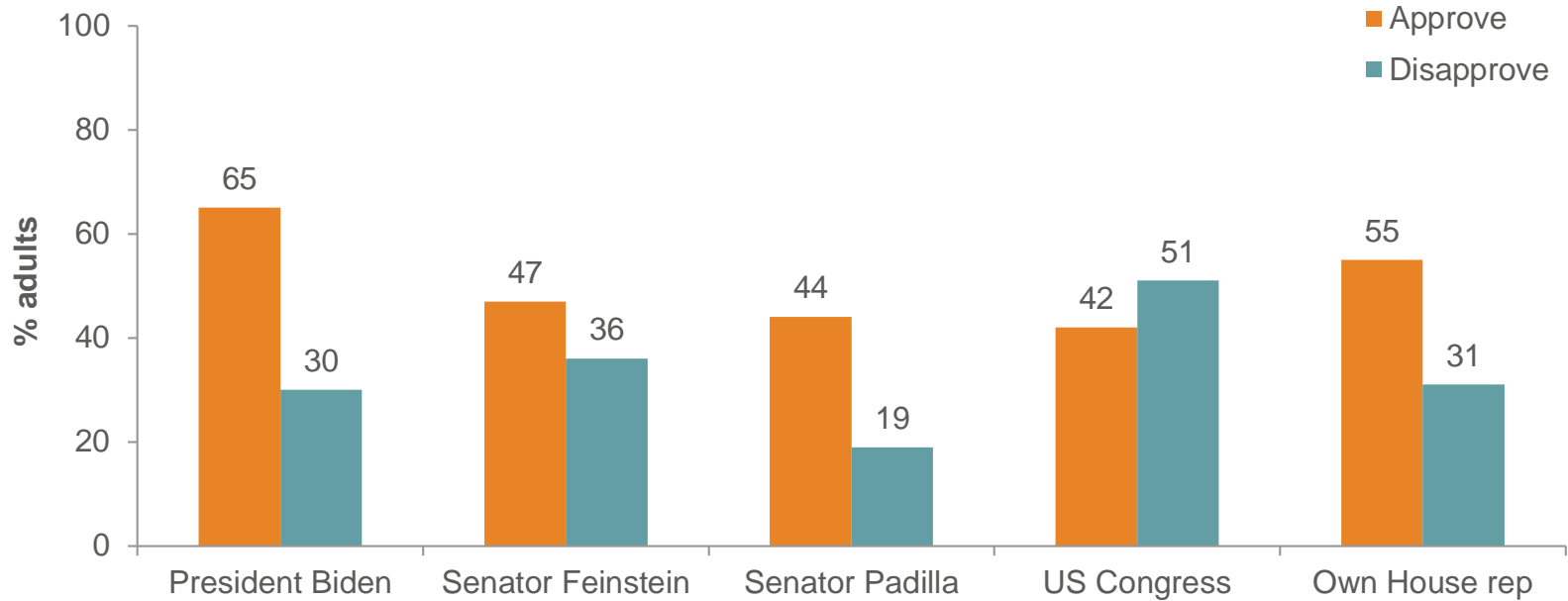
Housing costs and moving

Does it make you consider moving elsewhere in California, or outside of the state?

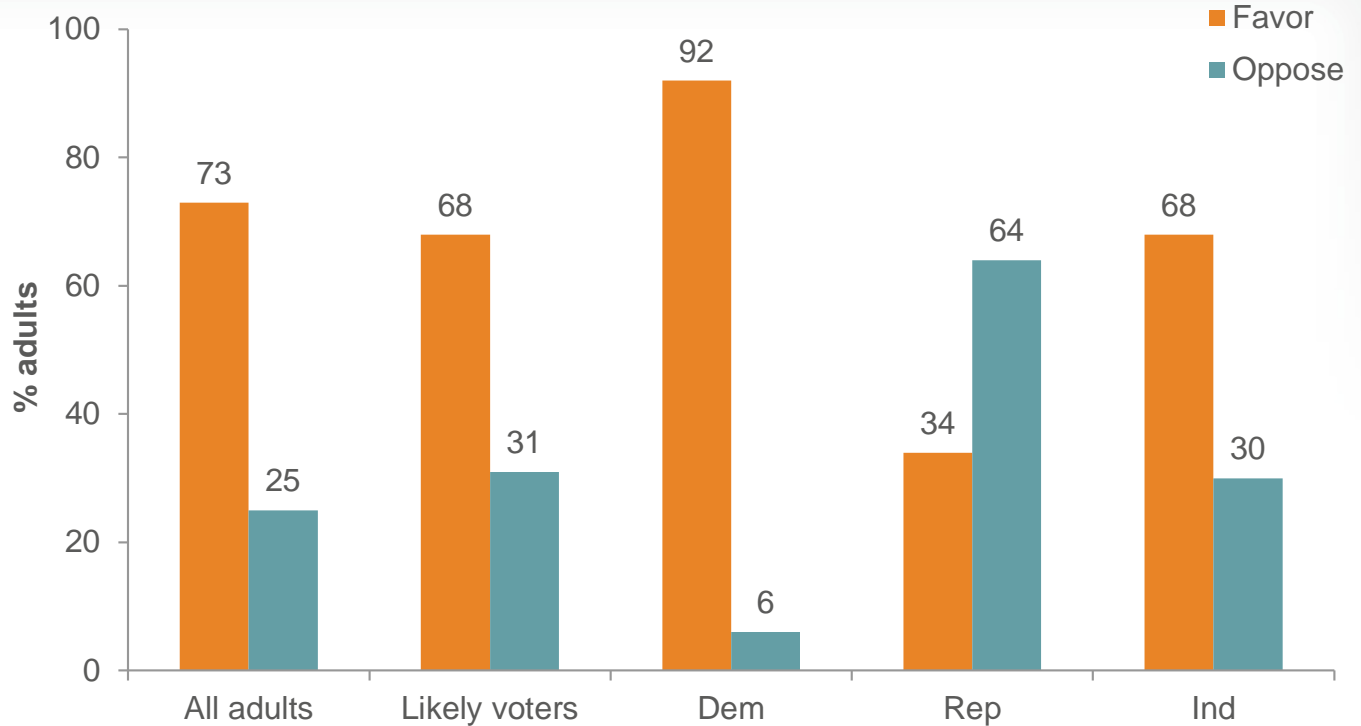


Approval of federal elected officials



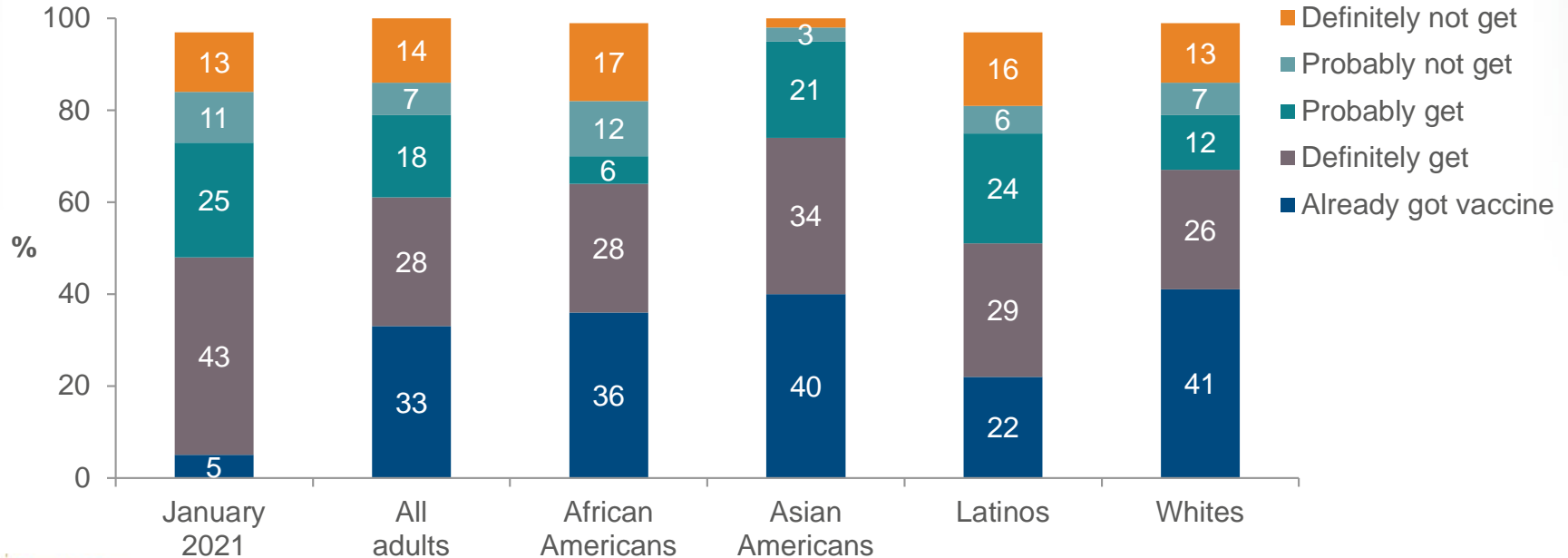
Federal \$1.9 trillion stimulus package

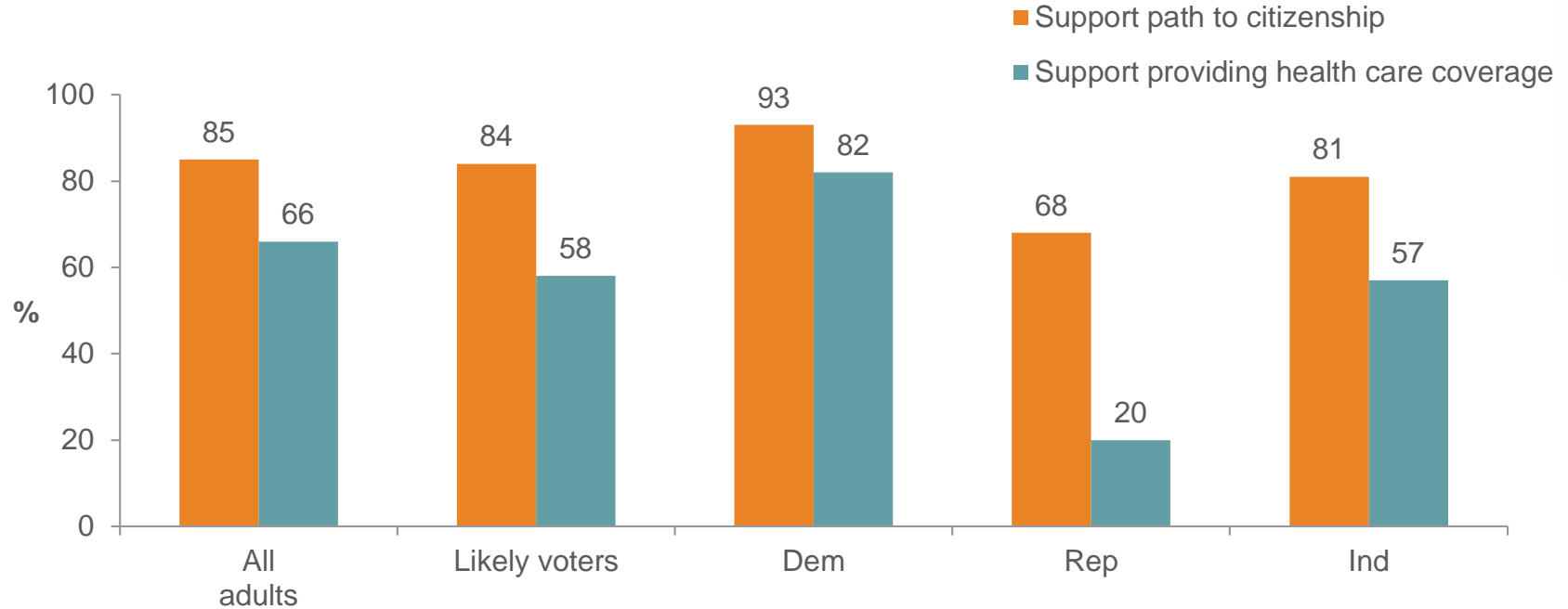


Attitudes toward getting COVID-19 vaccine

When it becomes available to you, will you definitely get the vaccine, probably get it, probably not get it, or definitely not get it?

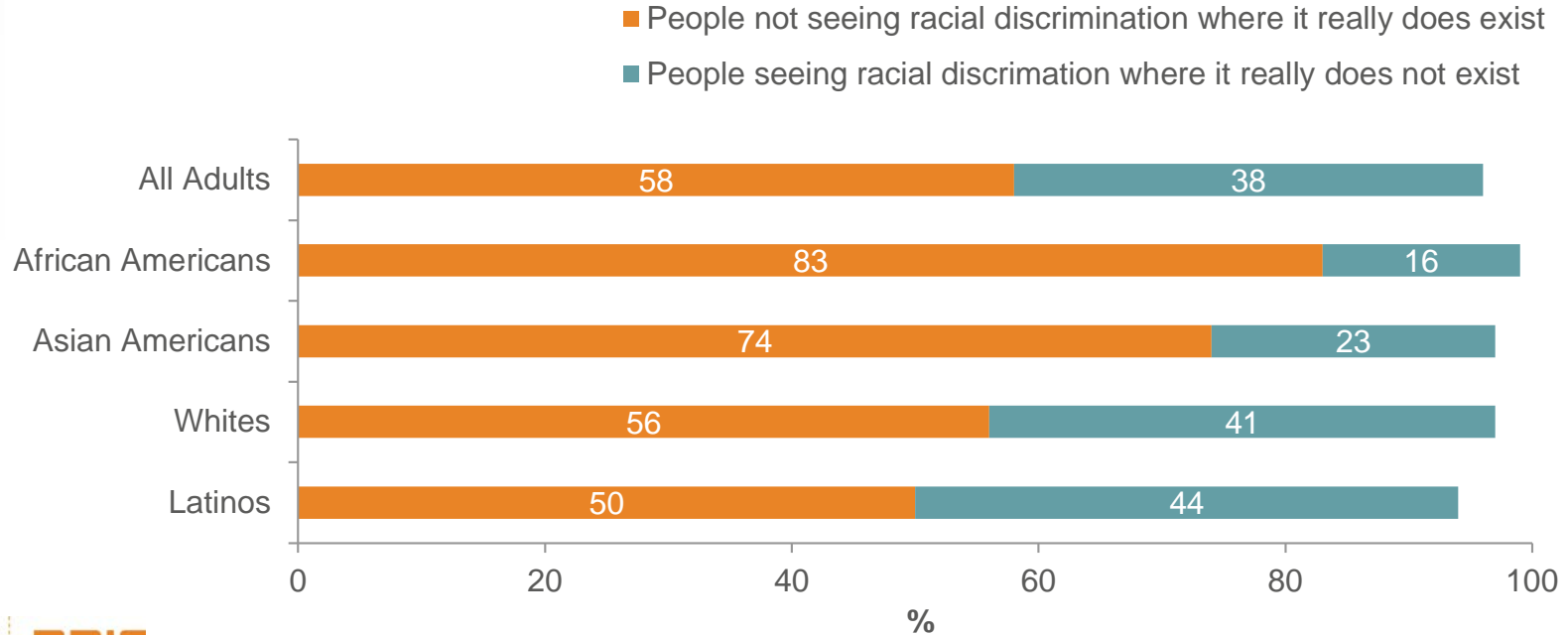


Policies impacting undocumented immigrants
