
- PPIC Survey series on state and national issues since 1999
- Public perceptions, attitudes, and policy preferences
- Telephone interviews, October 14–23, 2022
 - 74% cell phone, 26% landline
 - 1,715 adults, $\pm 3.9\%$ margin of error
 - 1,111 likely voters, $\pm 5.1\%$ margin of error

Californians are divided on whether the state is going in the right or wrong direction




About four in ten adults say their personal finances are worse off than they were a year ago

■ Better off ■ Same ■ Worse off




Partisans are divided on the approval of state elected officials

■ Democrats ■ Republicans ■ Independents




If the election were held today, likely voters would reelect Governor Newsom



Support falls short of a majority for Propositions 26, 27, and 30




The share voting "yes" on Propositions 26, 27, and 30 varies across subgroups




Few Californians think the US is headed in the right direction




Partisans are deeply divided on the approval of federal elected officials




Six in ten likely voters say the issue of abortion rights is very important in their vote for Congress this year




A majority of likely voters favor the Democratic congressional candidate in their district
