# Californians and Their Government November 2019 Time Trends – Likely Voters

# Methodology Note:

Findings for November 2019 are based on a survey of 1,711 California adult residents, with 70 percent interviewed on cell phones (1,200 interviews) and 30 percent interviewed on landline telephones (511 interviews). Live landline and cell phone interviews were conducted in English and Spanish according to the respondents' preferences. Interviews took an average of 18 minutes to complete. Interviewing took place on weekend days and weekday nights November 3-12, 2019.

The November 2019 sampling error for the 1,008 likely voters, taking design effects from weighting into consideration, is  $\pm 4.3$  percent. Sampling error is only one type of error to which surveys are subject. Results may also be affected by factors such as question wording, question order, and survey timing.
